3. Leeds Bradford Airport

- Major concerns that if successful the number of night flights will significantly increase.

Local issues

Weetwood Road. LCC Highways and Transportation published a proposal to make part
of this road one way in order to deal with the traffic gridlock at the end of the school
day. Concerns from residents re lack of consultation, short time span for objections

- and likelihood of it being successful. GS contacted Councillors and Emma Flint is seeking an extension to the deadline for comments/consultation.
- Back Wellburn Avenue. Letters sent to residents and businesses re refuse bins.
 Enforcement Officer from Planning Services has visited the site and advised some work to be done which is now completed.
- 5. Lawnswood Roundabout
 - We understand that the opposition parties in LCC used a 'Call in' process to propose that the current plan is not value for money at over £13 million.
 - No further news as yet.
- 6. Inner North west Community meeting 13 December 2023.
 - Attended by MM
 - Covers an area from Little London to West Park and looks at community projects and concerns. The Otley Run continues to be a major concern.
